Policy 1.0X: International Students in F-1 status on a USCIS form 1-20 issued by Salt Lake Community College (SLCC) are required to have, as part of the International Student Enrollment requirement, proof of immunizations for Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR). Additionally, they are required to be screened for Tuberculosis (TB) and any additional immunization requirements mandated by local, State, or Federal Statute.

- Complete blood tests to show immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella. You may visit the Center for Health & Counseling to complete these tests.
- As an F1 International Student, you are also required to complete a Tuberculosis (TB) Screening, which may require additional testing. You may also complete this test at the Center for Health & Counseling.
