TOTAL COHORT

Beginning the Fall Semester of the 2009 Academic Year, 2,373 first-time full-time students attended Salt Lake Community College of which 1,208 were male and 1,165 were female students. These 2,373 students identified themselves as the following race/ethnicity:

White: 841 males and 747 femalesHispanic: 160 males and 174 females

• Black: 41 males and 37 females

• Asian: 40 males 41 females

Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander: 24 males and 29 females
American Indian/Alaskan Native: 19 males and 31 females

Nonresident Alien: 9 males and 11 femalesTwo or more races: 2 males and 5 females

MALE SPORTS

Baseball

There were a total of 16 first-time, full-time students participating in baseball

- Race/Ethnicity: 15 White, 1 Hispanic
- 11 were on scholarship related to their participation in the baseball program. Of the 11 who received aid:
 - o Race/Ethnicity: 10 White, 1 Hispanic
 - 2 White students transferred
 - 2 White students graduated
 - 4 White students and 1 Hispanic student graduated
 - o 2 White students left for religious service

Basketball

There were a total of 8 first-time, full-time students participating in basketball

- Race/Ethnicity: 4 White, 4 Black
- 7 were on scholarship related to their participation in the basketball program. Of the 7 who received aid:
 - o Race/Ethnicity: 4 Black, 3 White
 - o 4 Black students and 1 White student transferred
 - o 2 White students left for religious service

FEMALE SPORTS

Basketball

There were a total of 8 first-time, full-time students participating in basketball

- Race/Ethnicity: 5 White, 2 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, 1 Black,
- 8 were on scholarship related to their participation in the basketball program. Of the 8 receiving aid:
 - Race/Ethnicity: 5 White, 2 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, 1 Black
 - 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander student transferred
 - 2 Black and 4 White students graduated
 - 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander student left the program

All Other Sports

There were a total of 17 first-time, full-time students participating in volleyball and softball

- Race/Ethnicity: 16 White, 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander
- 16 of the students were on scholarship related to their participation in volleyball and softball. Of the 16 receiving aid:
 - Race/Ethnicity: 15 White, 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander
 - 2 White students and 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander student transferred
 - o 10 White students graduated
 - o 3 White students left the program
