## TOTAL COHORT

Beginning the Fall Semester of the 2009 Academic Year, 2,373 first-time full-time students attended Salt Lake Community College of which 1,208 were male and 1,165 were female students. These 2,373 students identified themselves as the following race/ ethnicity:

## Basketball
