

2016-2017 ATHLETIC STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

TOTAL COHORT

Beginning the Fall Semester of the Academic Year 2013, 1,974 first-time, full-time students attended Salt Lake Community College, of which 943 were male and 1,031 were female students. These 1,974 students identified themselves as the following race/ethnicity:

- White: 556 males and 662 females
- Hispanic: 184 males and 213 females
- Black: 27 males and 21 females
- Asian:65 males 43 females
- Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander: 15 males and 24 females
- American Indian/Alaskan Native: 15 males and 9 females
- Nonresident Alien: 41 males and 14 females
- Two or more races: 32 males and 29 females
- Race/Ethnicity Unknown: 8 males and 16 females

ATHLETIC COHORTS

MALE SPORTS

Baseball

There were a total of 14 first-time, full-time students participating in baseball. Of these students, 11 were white, 2 were two or more races, and 1 was Nonresident Alien. 10 were on scholarship related to their participation in the baseball program. Of those receiving aid, 2 White students transferred. 1 Two or more races student did not graduate. 1 Nonresident Alien transferred and 1 White student left for a church related mission. 1 White student did not graduate. 4 white students graduated.

Basketball

There were a total of 8 first-time, full-time students participating in basketball. Of these students, 2 were White, 4 were Black, 2 were Nonresident Aliens. 8 were on scholarship related to their participation in the basketball program. Of the 8 receiving aid, 2 were White, 4 were Black, and 2 were Nonresident Aliens. Of the 8 receiving aid, 1 Black student transferred, and 2 Nonresident Alien students transferred. 3 Black and 2 White students graduated.

FEMALE

SPORTS Basketball

There were a total of 6 first-time, full-time students participating in basketball. Of these students, 4 were White, 1 was Hispanic and 1 was Nonresident Alien. 5 were on scholarship related to their participation in the basketball program. Of the 5 receiving aid, 1 White student transferred. 3 White students and 1 Nonresident Alien student graduated.

All Other Sports

There were a total of 19 first-time, full-time students participating in Volleyball and Softball. Of the 19 students, 13 were White, 1 was Hispanic, 3 were Nonresident Aliens, 1 was a Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, and 1 was Two or more races. 17 of the students were on scholarship related to their participation in Volleyball and Softball. Of the 17 receiving aid, 11 were White, 3 were Nonresident Aliens, 1 was a Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, 1 was Hispanic and 1 was Two or more races. Of the 17 receiving aid 1 Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, 1 Hispanic, 3 Nonresident Aliens, and 11 White students, graduated. 1 Two or more races student did not graduate.
