- Competency-Based Education (CBE) is a different type of educational delivery model that SLCC is piloting that allows you to progress around your own schedule and the material you are learning, meaning you can complete coursework more quickly than a traditional format. However, CBE does not change the completion date for the semester or content of the course.
- CBE has a different grading mechanism than non-CBE courses. In CBE, you will only receive one of three possible grades: A, B, or E (fail). CBE is based on mastery of a skill for the grade; therefore, CBE mastery is defined as 80% or above.
- Students must complete all coursework by the end of the semester and achieve a grade of 80% or above to pass the CBE course.
- You may complete the course before the end of the semester if you choose to do so. You may not complete coursework after the end of the semester.
- All coursework will be submitted online through Canvas. Students must have reliable internet access to successfully complete their assessments.
- There are no assignment due dates; however, there will be suggested due dates to help you stay on track for completing the course by the end of the semester. You are more likely to succeed if you complete your work close to the suggested due dates. It is not likely you will complete all the course work in the last two weeks of the semester so plan on making regular progress.
- It is recommended that you contact your instructor weekly regardless of how much progress you make and update them on your plan to complete your assignments and request feedback.
- You will receive a tuition waiver for the cost of this CBE course (Utah residents only); however, you will be responsible to pay any additional fees such as student and/or course fees.
- If you receive an E in this course (less than 80% completion or competency), you will have the opportunity to re-take the course at your own expense in a non-CBE format.
