

HB144 Utah Non-Resident Tuition Waiver For Eligible Utah High School Graduates

GENERAL INFORMATION

Any student other than a non-immigrant, who meets all the following requirements, shall be exempt from paying the non-resident portion of the total tuition at Salt Lake Community College.

REQUIREMENTS

- The student must have attended a Utah high school for three or more years.
- The student must have graduated from a Utah high school or attained the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED) in Utah.
- The student cannot have registered at a Utah System of Higher Education institution earlier than Fall of 2002.
- Students must submit their official high school transcript(s) validating three year high school attendance in Utah and graduation from a Utah high school.
- A student, who is without lawful immigration status, must file an affidavit with Salt Lake Community College stating that he or she has filed an application to legalize immigration status or will file an application as soon as he or she eligible to do so.
- Students who are non- immigrants' visa must submit a copy of a valid visa. (F student visa, B visitor visa).
- Student must file an exemption request and include a signed Salt Lake Community College affidavit that indicates the student has met all applicable condition describe above. Student information in this process remains strictly confidential unless Federal and/or State law requires disclosure.
- Transfer students must include an official high school transcript with this Application and affidavit to substantiate, a three year high school attendance in Utah and graduation from a Utah high school.
- Transfer students eligible for this exemption must submit a new request (and documentation required) to each college under consideration.
- Students meeting the criteria will be exempt from payment of non-resident portion of tuition; but continue to be classified as non-residents.
- HB-144 does not provide financial aid eligibility. These students remain ineligible for state and federal financial aid.

PROCEDURES FOR REQUESTING A UTAH EXEMPTION FROM NON-RESIDENT TUITION AT SALT LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

1. If you are a new or returning student, fill out and sign the HB144 Utah Non-Resident Tuition Waiver on the reverse side of this form.
2. Request an official transcript (in a sealed envelope) indicating completing of at least three years in a Utah high school and proof of graduation from a Utah high school or have an equivalency of a high school diploma (GED) in Utah.
