Apprenticeship training is classroom related instruction designed to provide the apprentice with knowledge of theoretical and technical aspects of their craft.

Why SLCC?

Students learn the theoretical and technical aspects necessary to be successful in their respective craft that are typically not learned on the job-site.

Apprenticeship programs are not eligible for financial aid, but several scholarships are available for qualified students. Books are additional and for most programs will be purchased on a yearly basis.

The primary benefit of doing an apprenticeship program is that students are working and earning money while they are attending school. In most cases the tasks they are doing on the job will correlate directly with the curriculum they are learning in the classroom.

Faculty members are selected from industry and are at least journeyman level professionals with at least 6 years experience.

Time?

Most apprenticeship programs take 3-4 years to complete depending on the craft.

Cost?

Tuition for apprenticeship courses are approximately half the regular SLCC tuition.

Preparation?

Students are required to be employed and working in the industry while attending school.
