PLACEMENT TEST REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS

Concurrent Enrollment students, along with all other SLCC students, will be required to provide placement test scores at the time of admission to SLCC beginning summer 2008. Placement scores have been required of students taking math and English in the past; now the scores will be required of all students.

The requirement is intended to evaluate student readiness for college-level coursework. ACT scores or the Accuplacer (CPT) test scores may be used. Students taking the Accuplacer test must complete both the math and English sections of the test. Students not demonstrating college readiness by obtaining an ACT reading score of 20 or placing in English 1010 on the Accuplacer test are advised to improve their reading skills. Students not ready for college level math will be directed to improve their math skills. Students not reading at college level may not be eligible to take some classes such as English and biology. Students may be able to take the Accuplacer (CPT) test in their high schools or at a college campus. We are still in the planning process, and will provide more details as we work them out.

NEW SLCC CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ACADEMY

The SLCC Academy is a new program intended to assist students by providing Concurrent Enrollment classes on campus after school and during the summer.

The Academy will offer Concurrent Enrollment courses planned to supplement the course offerings available in most high schools. Courses will be selected to assist students who are attempting to complete an associates degree while still in high school. Watch for more information in the spring newsletter.

REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS WORKING TOWARD THEIR ASSOCIATE DEGREE

- ➔ Apply for SLCC graduation by November 1st and April 1st; there is a \$20 graduation application fee.
- ➔ Did you know that students graduating with their degree in June or August are eligible to participate in the SLCC graduation ceremony?
- ➔ The SLCC graduation ceremony will take place on Friday, May 2nd. If you would like to participate in the ceremony, contact Linda in the Graduation Office at 957-4035.
- ➔ Registration for classes on campus Spring Semester 2008 has begun, so gather your Early Enrollment Admission paperwork and meet with Holly or Paula ASAP!
- ➔ Registration for classes on campus Summer 2008 will begin in April. Meet with Holly or Paula in March for Early Enrollment Admission.
- ➔ SLCC Concurrent Enrollment Orientation for New Students will begin in January 2008, so remember to sign up early!!

QUALIFICATION SCORES

To qualify for Concurrent Enrollment Math and English courses, students must have the following scores before the class begins:

MATH 1010	CPT elementary algebra score of 54 or above	ACT math score of 18 or better	
MATH 1050	CPT college level math score of 43 or above	ACT math score of 23 or better	Math 1010 with a C or better on transcript
ENGL 1010	CPT elementary English score of 81 or above	ACT reading score of 20 or better	

LOG-ON TO 'MYPAGE'

MyPage is the easiest way to view the semester class schedule, view your grades, view your transcript, and view your college e-mail, as well as to learn about special services available to you as a student. If you prefer, you can forward your SLCC e-mail to your personal e-mail address.

To obtain your MyPage user name and password, go to mypage.slcc.edu and click on "Need Your Username/Pass." You will need your SLCC student ID or S number. Once you have entered the requested information, your login information (user name and password) will be displayed. This information will only pop up one time, so write this information down so that you have your username and password when you are ready to log on. You can access your MyPage account by logging onto www.slcc.edu via any computer on or off campus

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ORIENTATION

Beginning January of 2008, upon applying for Concurrent Enrollment admission, and taking CE classes, you are required to attend an orientation meeting. ADVANCE PLACEMENT (AP) AWARDING

To have AP credits applied to your SLCC transcript you must complete the following steps;

Step 1

Fill out the Transcript Evaluation form.

- ➔ List all of your AP courses under 'Subject'.
- ➔ You may leave the 'College' field blank.

Step 2

Submit the form on-line.

Step 3
