

# Emergency Medical Technician



The Emergency Medical Technician Program satisfies the certification requirements for those who are interested in becoming an Emergency Medical Technician. This training is designed to prepare the student for the real world of medical care by giving the knowledge, skills, hands-on experience, and the technical background to provide such care. The training is also applicable to Law Enforcement and private security personnel. To be certified by the State of Utah, **you must be 18 years of age and have no major felony convictions**. You must **attend all** scheduled classes. Orientation and lecture classes are held at the Miller Campus, 9750 south 300 west. This program currently consists of 144 hours, taken over a 12 week quarter. It may be taken for 10 elective **college credit hours or for non-credit**.

Course Fees: Credit or non-Credit is **\$1203.00**, plus books and certification fees.

Students attending SLCC for the first time are required to pay a **\$40.00 admission fee** whether you are a non-matriculated (non-degree seeking status) or matriculated (degree seeking status) Student. If you are a degree seeking Criminal Justice Major, you should consult with James Hoffman (801) 957-3211 prior to registration.

**Additional Costs:** Approximate book and supply cost: **\$125.00**. Student is responsible for **State Certification fees:** resident **\$145.00**, non-resident **\$180.00**.

**Pre-Requisites:** Student should be C-Level (Health Care Provider) Utah State CPR Certified upon entering the EMT class. If the student is not, there will be a **CPR Certification class** available for an additional **\$35.00 fee**.

**Course Content:** Treatment of medical emergencies, including trauma injuries, shock treatment, bleeding, illness, bandaging, splinting, taking of vital signs.

**Financial Aid:** You may apply for financial aid on line [www.slcc.edu](http://www.slcc.edu). You must be admitted to the College and then apply. Do it early so the money will be ready for you. **The deadline for Spring Semester is October 1<sup>st</sup>, Summer deadline is February 1<sup>st</sup> and Fall deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Applicants must submit a completed EMT application with a \$100.00 deposit (**non-refundable**) money order, cashiers check or a personal check. Make all checks Payable to SLCC (Salt Lake Community College). Register at the Larry Miller Campus located at 9750 South 300 West, MPDC (Miller Professional Development Building) in room 110 SANDY, UT 84070, (801) 957-5200 (**Deposit is applied to your tuition and reserves you a seat in the next available class**).

**EMT Re- certification** CEIP 0410 consists of up to 100 hours of training per year designed for individuals holding current, valid certification. The student will select from the ongoing HLTH 2300 course needed days. This course provides the required CME hours for the currently certified EMT.
