Healthcare professionals with proficient Spanish speaking skills will learn to improve communication with patients, patient care outcomes and Spanish medical language. The primary focus will be vocabulary related to assessing medical history and medical problems, as well as related cultural aspects to effectively communicate with patients and families.

Students work at their own pace during this 13-module course, completing modules by weekly due dates.

Recommended Prerequisites: Spanish 2020 or equivalent. Students' proficiency levels should allow them to express themselves correctly in major tenses and they should already posses a large general vocabulary.
