

# CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS TO THE ZINE BOX

Do you make zines? Get yours into the hands of readers and collectors during The City Library's 10<sup>th</sup> annual Alt Press Fest through the SLCC Community Writing Center's Letter Box Project.

The Letter Box Project is an old-school vending machine in the Community Writing Center which sells letters from strangers to anyone with a quarter. It will be temporarily renamed the Zine Box and displayed at **The City Library's Alt Press Fest on Sat. Oct. 13, 2018.**

**To have your zine(s) considered for distribution in the Zine Box, you must submit a vend-ready, assembled prototype for approval.** The subject matter and content of your zine should be appropriate for all age groups. There is no age limit for submitters, and zines may be produced in any language. Zines should not be created with materials that are potentially hazardous or perishable.

With your zine prototype, please **include a cover letter with your contact information including your name, email address, and phone number**, and indicate which zine size range you chose to produce (see below).

There are four zine size ranges:

- A. 5 - 6 ½ inches wide x 4 - 6 ½ inches tall x maximum of 1 inch deep
- B. 3 ½ - 4 ¼ inches wide x 5 - 7 ½ inches tall x maximum of 1 inch deep
- C. 2 - 2 ½ inches wide x 3 - 5 inches tall x maximum of ½ inch deep
- D. 3 - 3 ½ inches wide x 3 - 6 ½ inches tall x maximum of ½ inch deep

**Zine prototypes must be submitted by Tuesday, Sept. 10, 2018** in person or by mail to:

**If your zine prototype is accepted for distribution in the Zine Box, you will be invited to produce an edition of 10-20 zines (the exact amount is your choice within that number range). Zines must be delivered to the CWC by Monday, Oct. 8, 2018 at 7:30 p.m.**

Editions of the selected zines will be distributed at the Alt Press Fest for 25 cents each. Quarters will be made available at the fest for anyone who doesn't have one. All proceeds from the Zine Box will go to continuing the Letter Box Project.
