

## Posting of Banners

Many of you have noticed there are blue posts up around the campuses. They were made to hold up to an 8' (or less) by 2' banner. There is enough room to hold two banners one on top of the other if we share the space. Sometimes we can occupy up to an 8' long banner though that would have to depend on what is scheduled at the time. To make the process easier, the posts need to be reserved for all SLCC department or student groups, through the Student Life & Leadership Office. We are doing this in conjunction with Facilities in order to utilize the space as much as possible. These are great spots in heavy traffic areas or spots on campus so you can get your information out.

In addition to the blue posts there are also buildings that have eye hooks for hanging banners. This space needs to be reserved also. There is room on some for a 4' by 6' banner or in other areas an 8' by 6' long. We have the exact measurements for you to order banners to best fit these areas. All areas are outside unless noted. Here is the list of what is available now for you to start planning out. Space may be reserved up to 3 months in advance.

### South City Campus

- 1 pair of posts - East Entrance on the south side of the fountain
- 16' space – South Entrance
- 8' by 2' space – South Entrance inside, above Women's restroom

### Redwood Campus

- 1 pair of posts - Southeast corner on Redwood Road (north of the perimeter road)
- 1 pair of posts - Northwest corner of campus of the perimeter road
- 2 pairs of posts - West entrance to the campus on the perimeter road
- 8' space AD – West side of building, South of West main entrance facing Quad
- 8' space BB – Northwest corner of building facing West
- 8' space Library – Southwest corner of building facing West
- 16' space LAC – Northeast entrance facing North
- 16' space TB – West side by the bottom of the stairs

### Jordan Campus

- 1 pair of posts – in front of the flags at the campus entrance

### Meadowbrook Campus

- 1 pair of posts – Southeast corner of campus off 255 West
- 1 pair of posts – West entrance off of 300 West
