

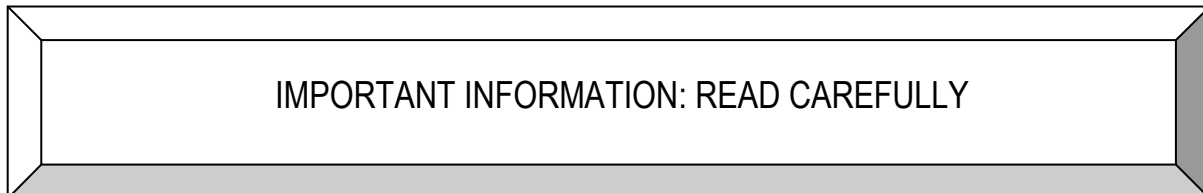


⇒ **Foundation Honors Scholarship:** This award is given to incoming freshman, transfer and continuing students based on cumulative GPA, letters of recommendation and answers to three questions. The number of scholarships available is contingent upon the amount of funds donated by the SLCC Foundation. This scholarship is awarded for tuition and fees based on the number of credit hours for which a student is registered. **Minimum GPA Requirement: 3.50. Requires at least ½ time enrollment (6-8 hours).**

- Completed scholarship application**
- Two current letters of recommendation from individuals with direct knowledge of your abilities and potential.
- College or high school transcript (if transfer student or incoming freshman)
- A separate sheet with answers to the following (please confine your answers to 1-2 paragraphs):
  1. Describe your educational and career goals.
  2. Describe one obstacle you encountered during your education (high school or college) and how you overcame it.
  3. Please describe the qualities you possess which will help you succeed in college.

⇒ **Foundation General Scholarship:** This award is given to incoming freshman, transfer and continuing students based on cumulative GPA, financial need (if desired), letters of recommendation and answers to three questions. The number of scholarships available is contingent upon the amount of funds donated by the SLCC Foundation. This scholarship is awarded for tuition and fees based on the number of credit hours for which a student is registered. **GPA Requirement: 2.50 – 3.49. Requires at least ½ time enrollment (6-8 hours).**

- Completed scholarship application**
- Two current letters of recommendation from individuals with direct knowledge of your abilities and potential.
- College or high school transcript (if transfer student or incoming freshman)
- Results of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) received in the SLCC Financial Aid Office (if you would like financial need considered)
- A separate sheet with answers to the following (please confine your answers to 1-2 paragraphs):
  1. Describe your educational and career goals.
  2. Describe one obstacle you encountered during your education (high school or college) and how you overcame it.
  3. Please describe the qualities you possess which will help you succeed in college.



For ALL scholarships, you must be admitted as a matriculated student by the deadline date based on the individual scholarship for which you are applying (received at SLCC or a postmark deadline). Unless noted, scholarships are open to **Utah residents only.**

You are welcome to apply for more than one scholarship. A separate scholarship application must be submitted for each scholarship, along with all required paperwork including a transcript. For example, if you apply for two scholarships, you must submit two applications and all other required paperwork. .

Most scholarships will cover Fall and Spring Semesters only, not Summer Semester.

You can receive ONE tuition waiver or scholarship only, but you may apply for more than one.

Not all majors are eligible for scholarships and tuition waivers. Please check the Financial Aid page on the SLCC website for an up-to-date list of eligible majors and programs.

**All students may apply for financial aid, in addition to scholarships.** To apply for Title IV financial aid, you must do the following by **May 3**:

1. File U.S. income taxes for 2009 (you and your parents, if you are considered a dependent student).
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This may be completed online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or you can pick up an application at the SLCC Financial Aid Offices at the Redwood Campus, South Campus or Jordan Campus. Be sure to keep copies of all paperwork used to complete the application as you may be asked to submit these copies to the Financial Aid Office.
3. After you receive the results of your application, please contact the Financial Aid Office at 801-957-4410 to determine if there are any other forms you will need to complete.

The hours for the Financial Aid Office will vary, based on the campus. Please call 801-957-4410 for the hours of the Redwood Campus, 801-957-3352 for the hours of the South Campus, 801-957-2682 for the hours of the Jordan Campus and 801-957-3717 for the hours of the Sandy Campus.

In addition, extended hours are in effect at the beginning of each semester. Please call (801) 957-4410 for these hours.
