**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:** All students who will be in the U.S. on a visa will submit the following items:

1. **Application for Admission** Complete the International Student Application for Admission with the appropriate field of study. A \*\$65 non refundable fee must accompany the application.
2. **Financial Statement** Submit an official bank statement and a notarized Financial Statement (enclosed) from the bank account holder or sponsor. Faxed documents will not be accepted.
3. **No TOEFL Required** SLCC offers an Intensive English Program. Upon arrival students will take the Accuplacer test ([www.slcc.edu/testing](http://www.slcc.edu/testing)) to determine their level of English proficiency and college readiness. Students needing English as a second language will enroll 20 hours per week in the ESL Program.
4. **Official Proof of High School Graduation** or college transcripts with English translations.
5. **Copy of main passport pages** Include name, photo and passport expiration date.

## TRANSFER STUDENTS

6. **Notice of Intent to Transfer** Students transferring from schools within the U.S. must submit a Transfer Form completed by your previous school's designated school official (DSO).
