## **Programming or Service Highlights:** (Please use bullet format.)

- Offered twice monthly FAFSA Workshops to students; served 500 students and families.
- Conducted Financial Aid Workshops at various high schools. Presented Financial Aid Nights through FYE and Student Relations.
- Automated notification of appeal committee decisions to students, decreasing the amount of time students would have to wait to be notified.
- Automated Overpayment and Return of Funds notification to students to run in batch. This saves advisors crucial time and allows them to meet more often with students. This process logs when the notice is sent and allows the FAO to run reports using this information.
- Created algorithmic budgets for summer which excludes manual input by employees.
- Implemented period based budgeting.
- Served over 75,000 through in-person and telephone contacts.
- Decreased student loan default rate from 14.7% to 13.2%
