

Peggy,

We've received a few calls regarding the old personal preference day and I thought I would pass this along to you in case you are getting questions too...

Our history is that from 1984-2000 we had 9 holidays, 2 determined by the President (normally day after thanksgiving and day before Christmas), 1 personal preference day. 12 Total.

In 2002, the College added days, took away the personal preference day and ended up with 15 (depending on the year). This was in excess of Regent policy R821.

Now in 2009, the college has returned to 9 standard holidays and 3 days that are assigned by the President, still a total of 12. The 3 days are being assigned by the President, one the day after thanksgiving and two around the College closure.

All we get is 12 days, no matter how the College determines how to allocate them.
