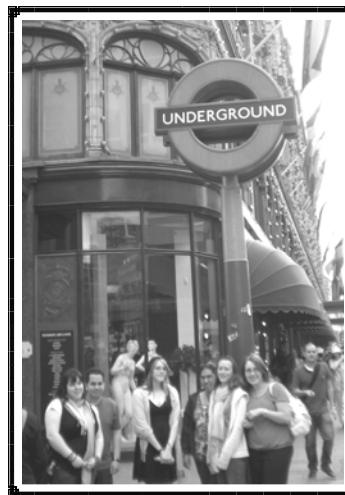

Program Overview

From the pageantry of Buckingham Palace to the bustling markets of Camden Town and Soho, London offers an eclectic mix of yesterday and today. In our three week trip, we will explore historical sites, the numerous immigrant communities, and open air markets, theaters, museums, and parks. We'll contemplate art at the National Gallery, have high tea, and observe life as it happens at Trafalgar Square. Of course, no trip to London would be complete without a visit to the Globe Theater, and in preparation for this trip we'll study at least one Shakespeare play. In addition, we'll read and discuss contemporary British fiction, as well as some of the greats from London's history, such as Arthur Conan Doyle, Dickens, and Samuel Johnson; and we'll learn about the economic, cultural and social intricacies of 21st century London. Excursions will include Stonehenge and Bath

Courses

All participant must enroll in the following course for Spring, 2010:
INTL 2980: STUDY ABROAD (3 CREDITS)

Participants must attend ALL pre-departure orientation sessions as well as ALL scheduled on-site educational and cultural learning activities.

All participants are required to attend Orientation Sessions at SLCC. Parents and/or guardians and spouses and/or partners are also invited to attend.

Lodging

Two to eight students per room with communal lavatories, washing, and bathing facilities. Except for breakfast, food is not included; however, cooking facilities are available for meal preparation.

Participant/Program Cost

\$3,350.00

Included

Round trip airfare from Salt Lake City to London; lodging; entrance and all venues on the itinerary; passes good for the tube (London subway) and buses; and the farewell dinner.

Not Included

Tuition; passport; meals; laundry; personal travel and expenses; any miscellaneous items not specifically listed; and gratuities.

Passport & Visa

You must have a valid passport for the England Study Abroad. Proof of passport due February 1, 2010 in Study Abroad Office, CT 258.



A minimum of 10 students is required for the England Study Abroad (15 students maximum).

If you are seriously considering this Study Abroad, turn in your application and a copy of the receipt for \$500.00 deposit to the Study Abroad office, CT 258, by November 23, 2009.

Be sure to keep a copy of your receipt.

Cancellations/Refunds

If the trip is cancelled prior to November 23, 2009, the deposit of \$500.00 will be refunded in full. Further refunds for withdrawal from this program after November 23, 2009, will be determined by the Study Abroad Director according to the recoverability of incurred costs and fees. Once the group leaves for England, all costs are non-refundable in their entirety.
