AP Exam Credit Procedure:

For AP Exam Credit to be awarded, students must be currently matriculated (degree seeking) at SLCC.

Official results must be sent directly from College Board to Enrollment Services at SLCC.

If you are potentially pursuing an associate's degree at SLCC, it is highly recommended that SLCC is listed as the initial college recipient of your AP exam scores.

If SLCC was not listed as a recipient when you took the AP exam, you must order an official AP Score Report. Please contact AP Score Reporting Services at 888-225-5427.

IMPORTANT

- SLCC will no longer accept AP scores reported on a high school or previous college transcript.
- AP scores must be a score of 3 or higher for credit to be awarded at SLCC.
- AP credit is posted in the order it is received; similar to any other college or university transcript received. Therefore, please plan ahead if you need credit posted to meet a transcript or application deadline. *No Exceptions.*
