<sup>A</sup> CSUB requires that students must complete one course from at least 3 of the following areas. The two letter code following each course indicates the general education distribution area that the course fulfills at SLCC. An interdisciplinary (ID) course from category #1, a Humanities (HU) course from category #2 and #4, and a Fine Arts (FA) course from category #3 is the recommended way to fulfill CSUB and SLCC requirements at the same time. **Keep in mind that for an AS Degree from SLCC, you need at least 3 credit hours of (ID), (HU) and (FA).**
