Through the process of filling out and submitting this form, a student's records indicate the catalog year to which their requirements are held.

CATALOG YEAR REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Students must complete major and minor requirements under a catalog no older than 6 years for a bachelor's degree and 3 years for an associate degree, respectively. Students who take longer to graduate must select a more recent catalog under which to complete their degree requirements. Students may also elect to graduate under the catalog which is in effect at the time they apply for graduation.
