Re: Strategy #9, Increase College Participation

Thank you for your efforts to advance this strategy. Your 2021-22 strategy report contained a review of the strategy's background, how your team approached the strategy, challenges encountered, and recommendations for continuing the work.

Key accomplishments this academic year include:

- 1. Secured a new scholarship awarding platform (ScholarshipUniverse) that improves access and functionality for both the Scholarships department and Institutional Advancement.
- 2. Continued translation of key Admissions/Marketing/Recruitment materials into Spanish.
- 3. Developed and implemented recruitment strategies to support growth in the following areas: Adult Students (first-time and some college), Male Students, and West Side Communities.
- 4. Analyzed the impact of federal, state, and college funds on enrollment, retention and completion. Specific analysis was completed on block grants and debt forgiveness.
- 5. Worked with DSA to lead conversations and communicate findings on the causes of the decline in higher education participation.

I have reviewed the recommendations from the strategy report and provided a response to each in the table below.
