#### **DIRECTIONS TO MAVERIK CENTER**


FROM SOUTH: Take I-15 Northbound to I-215 West. Take the 4700 South exit. Travel eastbound (right) to Redwood Road, Travel northbound (left) on Redwood Road to 3100 South. Travel westbound (left) on 3100 South to Decker Lake Drive. Travel southbound (left) on Decker Lake Drive to the Maverik Center, located on your immediate right.

FROM WEST: Take Bangerter Highway to 3100 South. Travel eastbound on 3100 South over the I-215 overpass to Decker Lake Drive. Travel southbound (right) on Decker Lake Drive to the Maverik Center, located on your immediate right. FROM EAST: Take I-80 westbound to state Route 201 toward West Valley City. Take state Route 201 westbound to Redwood Road. Exit Redwood Road going south (left) to 3100 South. Travel westbound 3100 South (right) to Decker Lake Drive. Travel southbound (left) on Decker Lake Drive to the Mayerik Center, located on your

FROM NORTH: Take I-15 South to state Route 201 toward West Valley City. Exit Redwood Road. At the base of the exit ramp, travel southbound (left) to 3100 South. Travel westbound (right) on 3100 South to Decker Lake Drive. Travel southbound (left) on Decker Lake Drive to the Maverik Center, located on your immediate right.

#### **MAVERIK CENTER PARKING**

If your graduation application is received after March 30, 2018 your name will appear on the list of graduates online but will not appear in the program that is issued at Commencement.



#### **CAPS & GOWNS**

Caps and gowns may be purchased in the College Store beginning March 27 for \$22 (including tax).



#### **HONOR CORDS**

Students achieving a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher by Fall Semester 2017 will earn an honor cord. Cords may be picked up at the College Store from March 27 to May 3, until 6 p.m. Note: School of Applied Technology & Technical Specialties competency-based certificate programs are not eligible for honor cords.
