

Dear High School Teachers,

Crossroads AHEC offers practical learning experiences for students. Our presenters assist your classes in identifying, understanding, and exploring various body systems, structures, and organs. We supply the materials needed for each lab, including the specimens for dissection or suturing. The presenter will also discuss healthcare careers related to the topic.

## **Heart Dissection**

This presentation starts with a brief overview of the heart's anatomy and the blood flow pathway. Students will work in pairs to dissect a pig heart, identifying the chambers, arteries, and valves. The presenter will guide the class through the dissection with an extra pig heart. This lab lasts 60-90 minutes and costs \$200 per class.

## **Integumentary System & Suturing**

After going over the integumentary system, we will teach the class how to do sutures. Students will work in pairs to practice tying knots, suturing, and removing sutures on a chicken wing. This lab lasts 45-60 minutes and costs \$120 per class.

## **Chicken Wing Dissection**

Students will review the musculoskeletal system and compare a chicken wing to a human arm. Students will work in pairs while they remove the skin to explore joints, muscles, bones, and connective tissues. The presenter will guide the class through their functions. This lab lasts 60 minutes and costs \$100 per class.
