Purpose

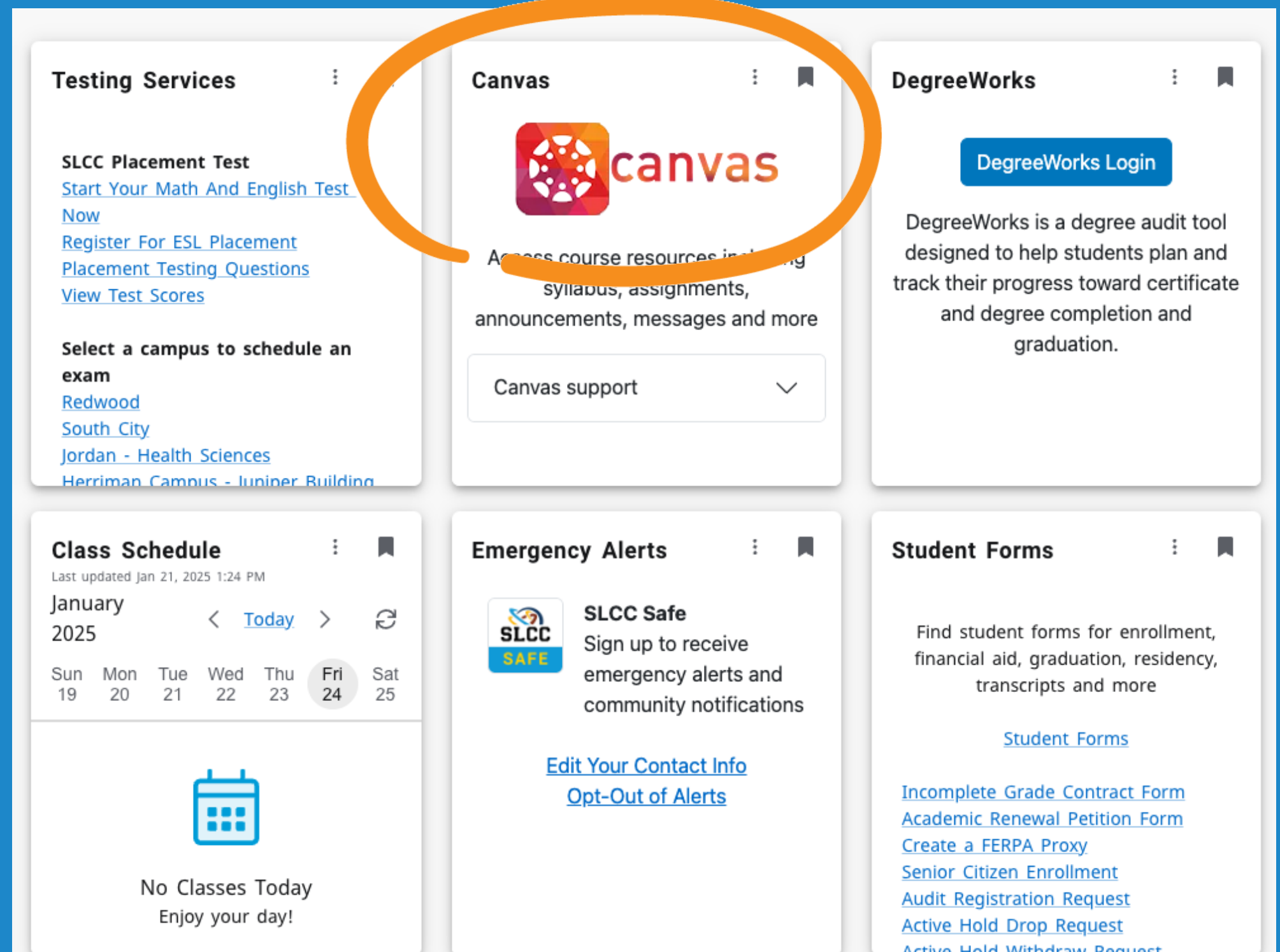
- Canvas is SLCC's learning platform or learning management system.

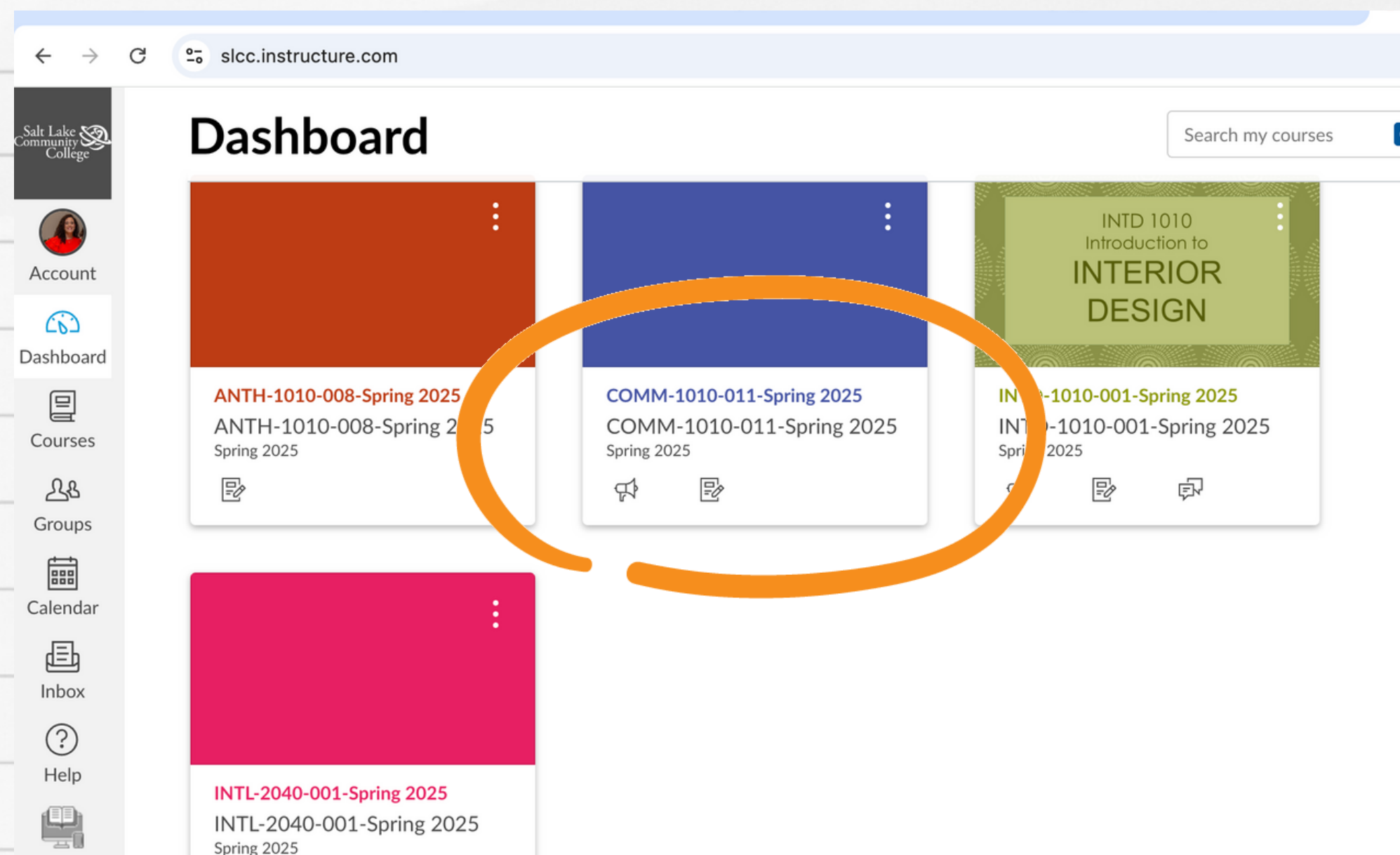

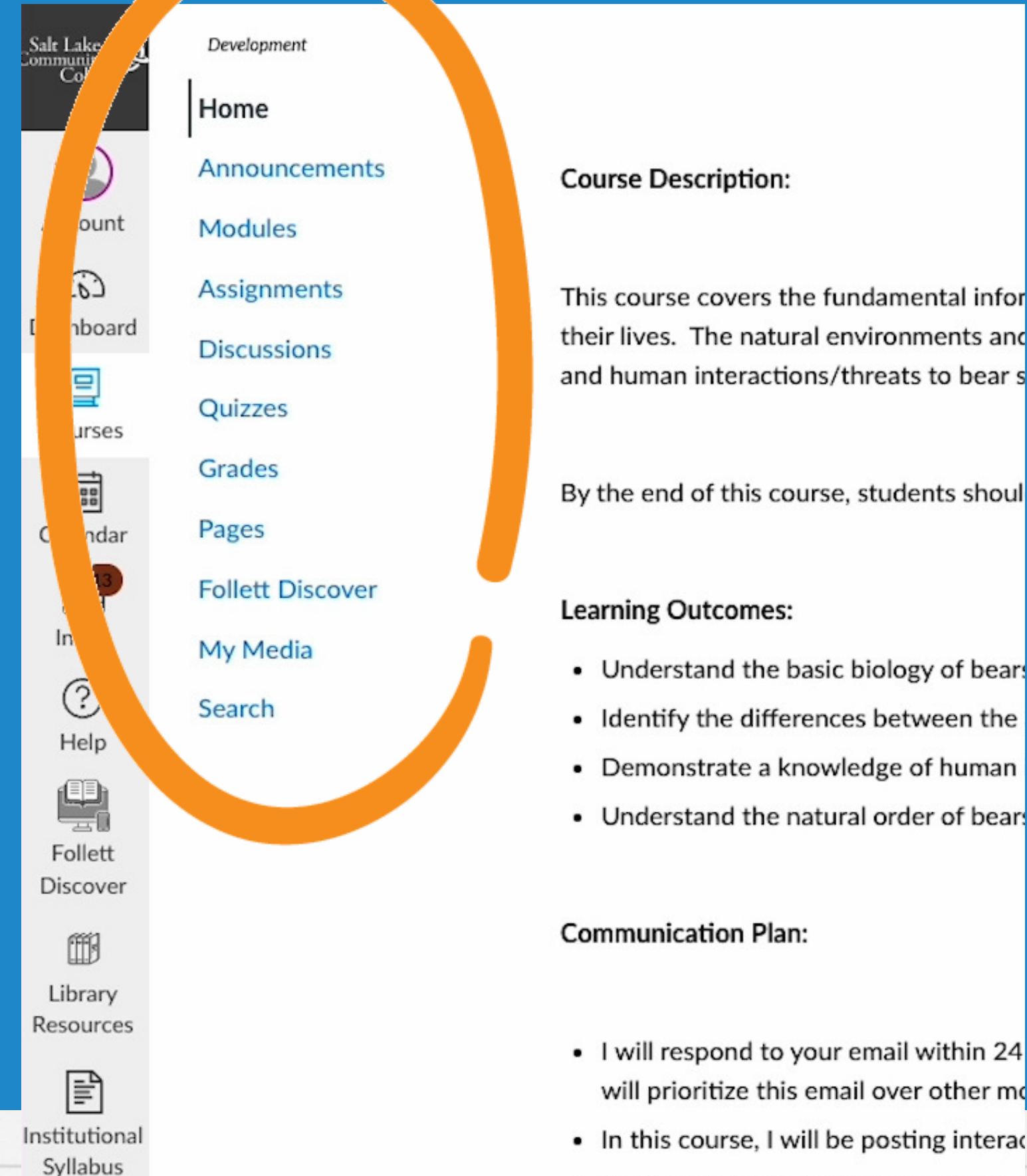
- Once you are logged in to your Canvas, you will see a list of courses you are enrolled in (Dashboard)

Some courses are broken down into Modules, which you can think of as sections of the course.

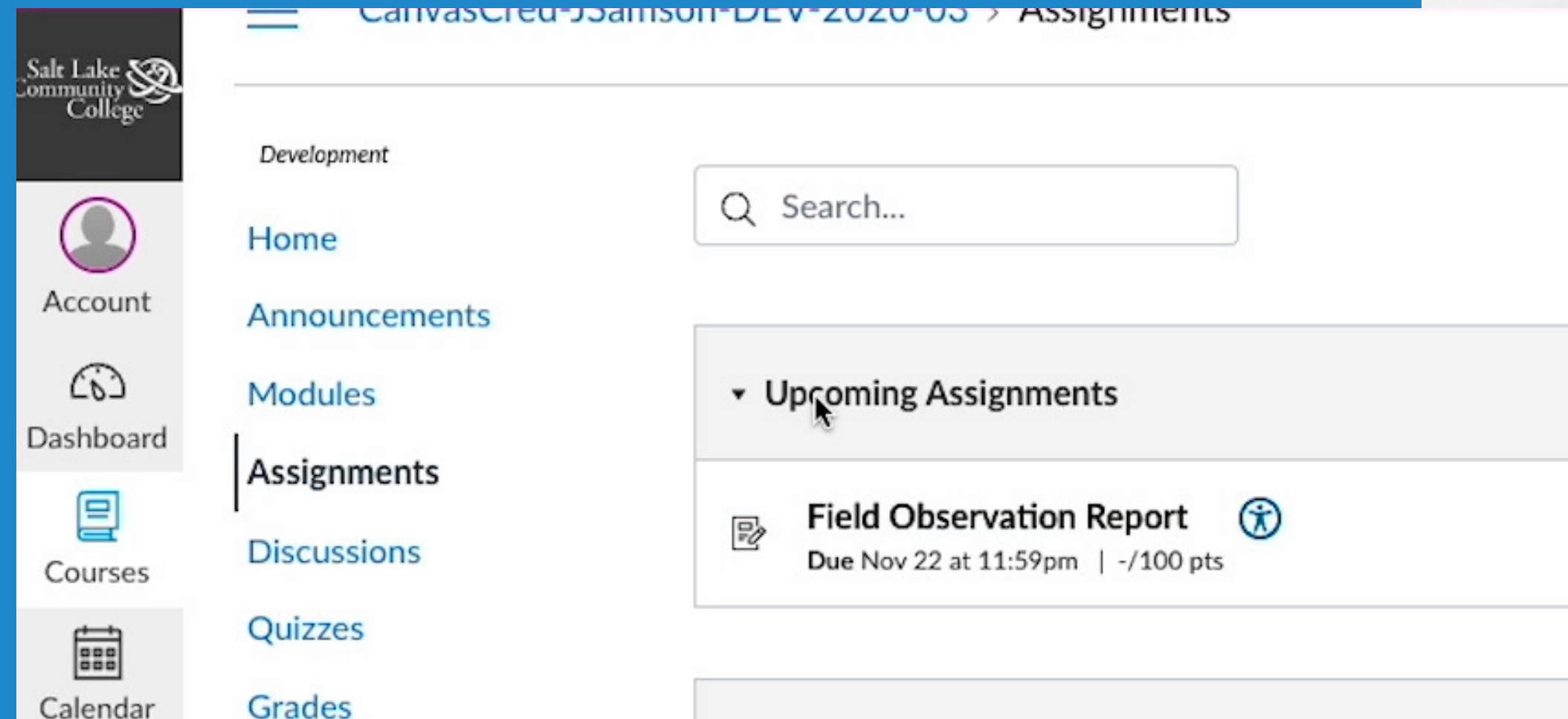
You complete all the elements of one module before moving on to the next one.

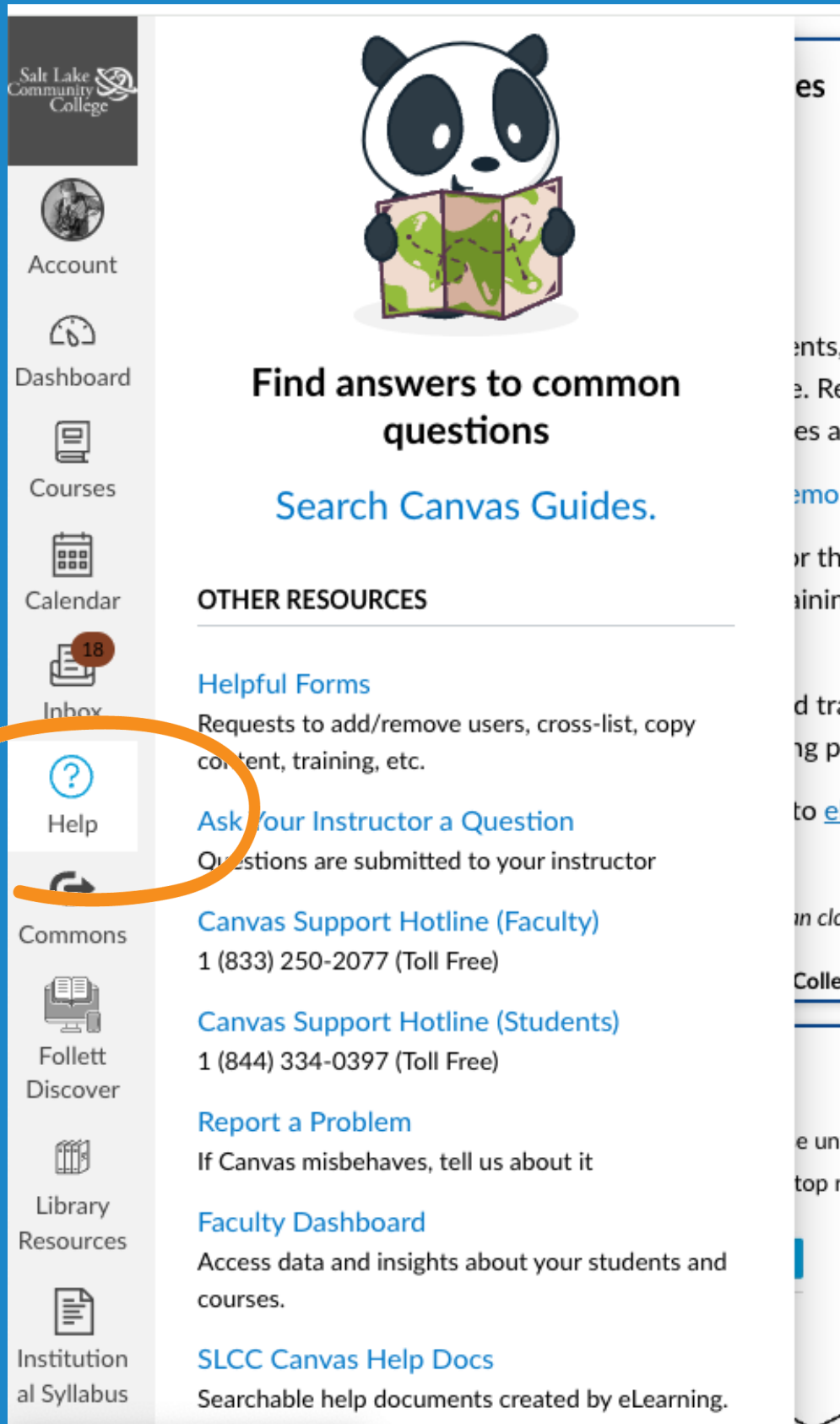
