Purpose

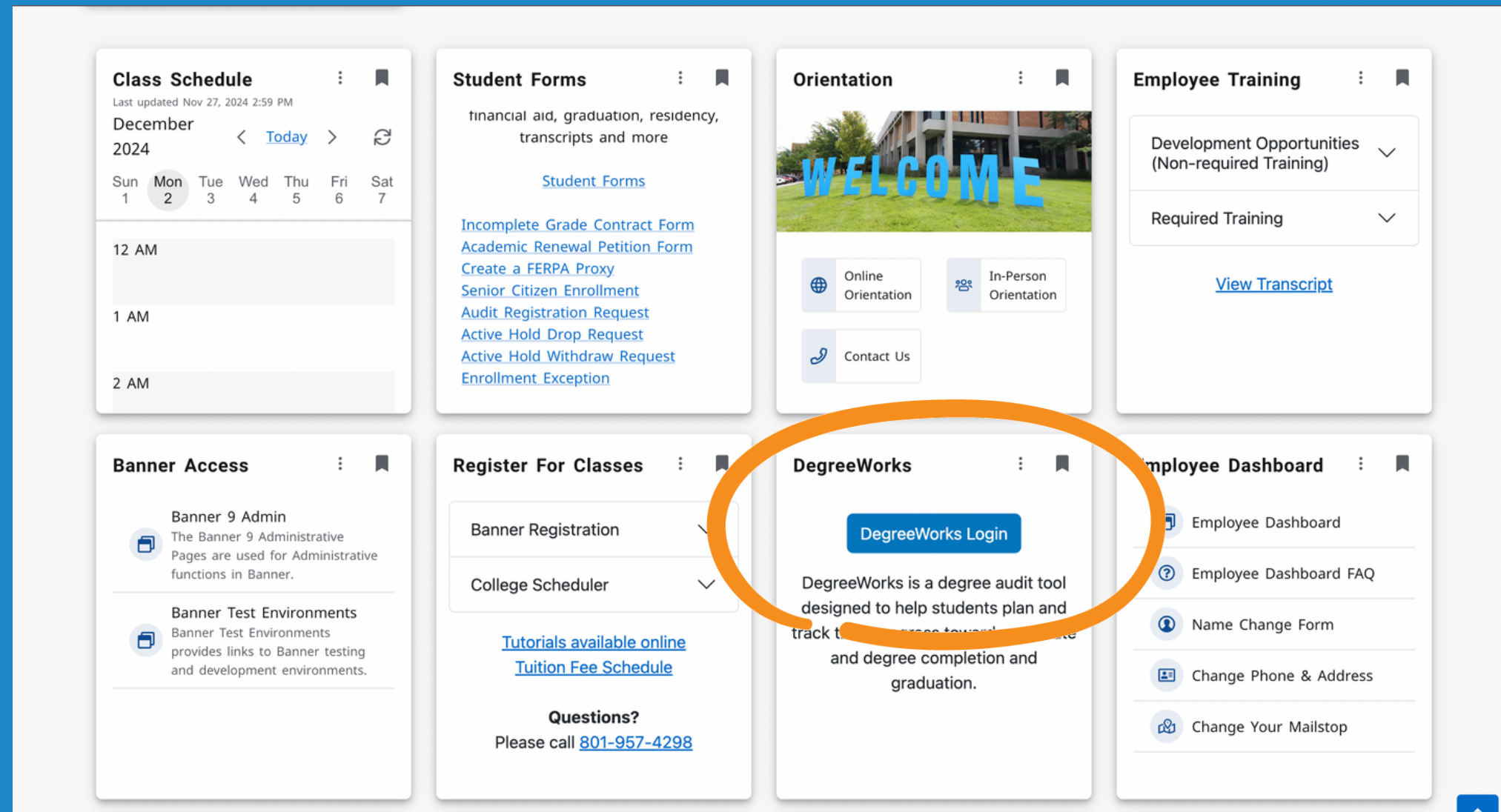
- Tracks progress for graduation

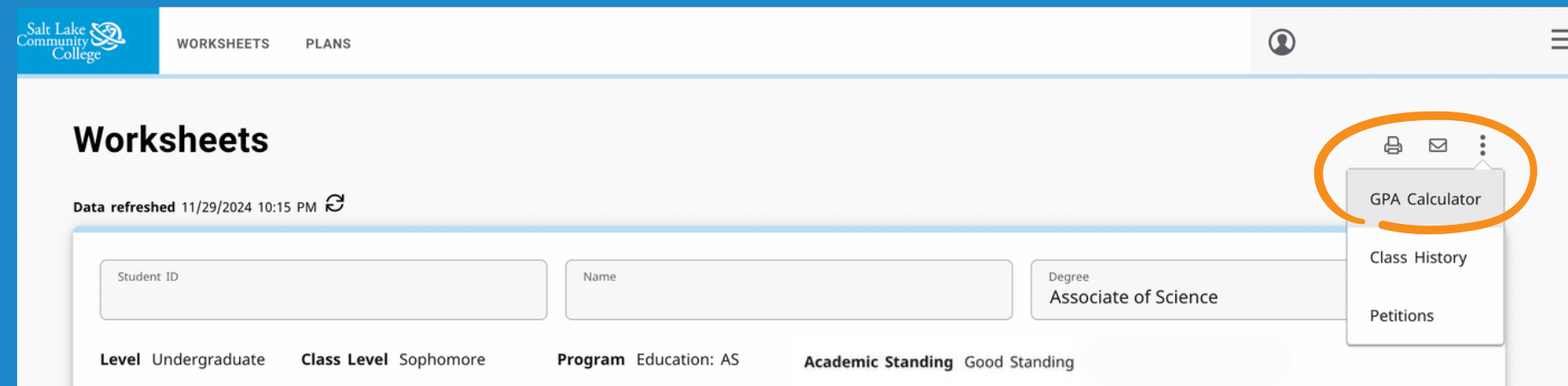
PREREQUISITE? COREQUISITE? WHAT DO THEY MEAN?



Prerequisite - A prerequisite is a class you have to take and pass before registering for another one. For example, you may have to pass Calculus I with at least a C or be taking Calculus right now before you can register for Calculus II for the next semester.

Corequisite - A corequisite is a class you have to take alongside another one. This is common in STEM classes that require a lab alongside a lecture. When registering for a class that requires a corequisite. For example, BIOL 1610 and 1615 must be taken together.

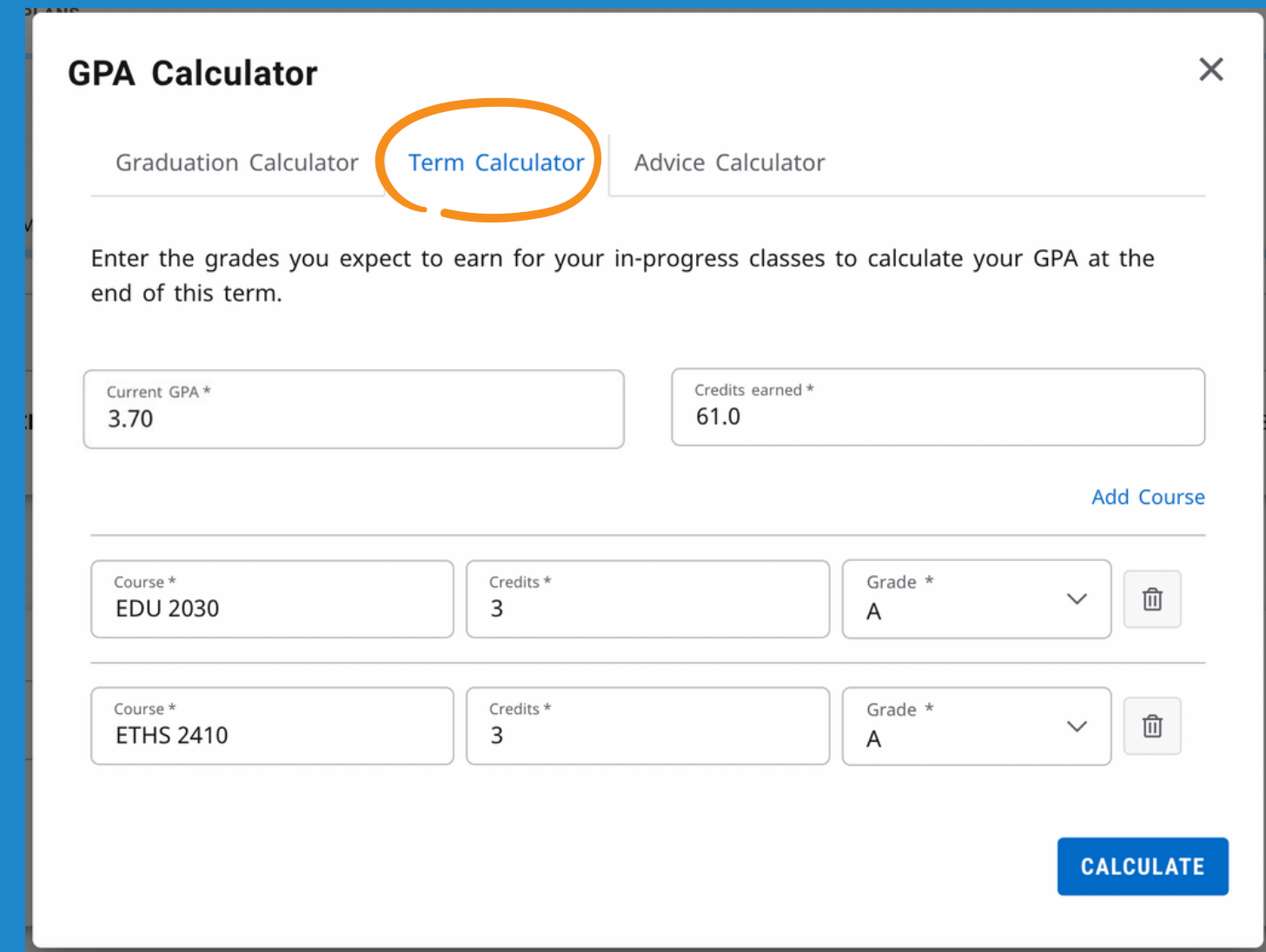
how to use GPA CALCULATOR
