

Teacher Education Scholarships

Teacher Recruitment Scholarship (TRS)

PURPOSE: To increase the number of teachers in Wasatch Front schools who backgrounds could best support underrepresented K-12 students in the state of Utah.

WHO SHOULD APPLY: High school students who want to pursue a career in teaching and whose background would help to support underrepresented students in K-12 schools. You must be a Utah resident with a high school GPA of 2.5 or higher.

WHAT IT COVERS: Tuition and fees

Access to free textbooks

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Take 15 credit hours per semester
- 2. Take 2 EDU/FHS classes each semester
- 3. Maintain a 2.5 GPA your first year, then maintain a 3.0 GPA your second year
- 4. Attend your scholarship class (EDU 1003) with no more than 2 absences each semester

Teacher Education Initiative Scholarship (TEI)

PURPOSE: To address the teacher shortage by recruiting, retaining, and training teachers to teach in the state of Utah.

WHO SHOULD APPLY: Any student who would like to pursue a career in teaching and who has earned a GPA of 3.0 or above.

WHAT IT COVERS: Tuition and/or fees

Access to free textbooks

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Take 12 credit hours per semester
- 2. Take 2 EDU/FHS classes each semester
- 3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- 4. Attend your scholarship class (EDU 1003) with no more than 2 absences each semester
