Community-Engaged Learning (CEL)

Community-Engaged Learning (i.e., service-learning) is a course of competency-based, credit bearing, educational experience in which students (a) participate in mutually identified service activities that benefit the community, and (b) reflect on the service activity in such a way as to gain further understanding of course content, a broader appreciation of the discipline, and an enhanced sense of person responsibility (Bringle & Clayton, 2012, p. 105; adapted from Bringle & Hatcher, 1996).
