- What is the program?
A loan that will not have to be repaid as long as the student works in certain fields.
- Who is eligible to participate?
Students who are enrolled in the following programs of study:
 - Computer Science & Information Systems
 - Network Systems
 - Business and Personal Computing
- What are the other requirements?
 - You must have completed at least 12 hours at SLCC with a GPA of 2.75 or higher
 - You must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 hours during Fall 2020 and/or Spring 2021.
 - You must complete an in-person entrance counseling
 - You must sign an agreement to complete the program and work in the field for an agreed upon time
 - If you are receiving other types of aid, you must show financial need.
