## **USHE Systemwide Funding**

- Life Sciences Work Force Initiative \$2,000,000 (on-going) and \$2,000,000 (one-time)
   Support priority occupations identified by industry to provide the volume of workers needed to support the rapidly expanding Life Science industry. Funding will also be used to create apprenticeship and skills-based learning programs as well as Technical College Certifications for specialized Automation Technicians, Industry Techs, and specialized Production Technicians.
- Talent Ready Connections \$1,000,000 (one-time)
   The Talent Ready Connections program is an initiative administered by Talent Ready Utah (TRU) to create Apprenticeship and Skills-Based programs focused on Work-Based Learning for high demand occupations in collaboration with educational institutions (USHE, USBE) and industry partners.
