Summer 2027 Cohort | Selective Admissions Requirements

Before you apply

Complete all prerequisites, verify transfer credit, complete the required SJT, confirm your Utah LPN license is current and unencumbered, and gather every supporting document.

1. Complete the prerequisites

All prerequisite courses, or equivalent transfer credit, AP, or CLEP, must be completed by the Advanced Placement Nursing application deadline.

- All courses and labs require a C or higher.
- NRSG 1230/NURS 1001 Pathophysiology requires a C+ or higher and must be within five years of application.
- Courses below the required grade will not be considered.

Science GPA requirement

Applicants must have an overall science prerequisite GPA of 2.75 or higher.

2. If you have transfer credit

- Send transcripts with posted grades to the [Transfer Evaluation Office](#) by March 15 for fall sessions, August 1 for spring sessions, or October 30 for summer sessions.
- Ensure transfer credit is fully posted before the deadline.
- Declare Healthcare Sciences as your Area of Study and Nursing as your Program of Study. The program information should match the transfer evaluation request.

3. Upload proof of high school completion

Upload proof of high school graduation or a GED. Documentation may include a transcript, diploma, or a letter of explanation if supporting documentation is unavailable.

4. Upload Nursing Essential Functions Form

Please review the document carefully, by signing you are vouching that you possess the required [essential functions](#) to successfully perform duties within the program.

5. Complete the required SJT

The Situational Judgement Test (SJT) is required **before** application submission. It includes 30 ethics-based scenarios and has a one-hour time limit.

- Testing window: October 1 through January 15.
- Take the SJT at an SLCC Testing Center during the open application session.
- A non-refundable \$30 testing fee is due at the time of registration.
- Only one attempt is allowed. Additional attempts will disqualify the application.
- Applications submitted without a completed SJT will not be considered, a second application may not be submitted.
- Final scores are not provided to applicants.

Schedule the SJT

- Log in to MySLCC and open the Testing Services tile.
- If the tile is not visible, use Discover or Discover More, search for testing, and pin Testing Services.
- Choose a Testing Center: Redwood, Jordan, South City, or Herriman.
- In RegisterBlast, select Health Science Pre-Admission and then Nursing Summer 2027. Register only for the Nursing Summer 2027 assessment; choosing the wrong exam will invalidate the results.
- Add the exam to the cart and select Complete Registration.
- Use the BruinMail confirmation to self-enroll in the Canvas course before arriving to test.

6. Upload your Utah LPN license

Your LPN license must be current, unencumbered, and in good standing in Utah. Upload a copy clearly showing the license number.

7. Optional items for additional consideration

Additional consideration may be given for the following documented items:

LPN patient-care experience

More than 12 months. Submit a signed employer letter on letterhead describing the job title, length of employment, and duties performed.

AHEC program

Graduation from an AHEC program.

Advanced writing

ENGL 2010, ENGL 2100, or HONS 2211 with C or higher.

American Institutions

ECON 1740, HIST 1700, or POLS 1100 with C or higher.

Lifetime Activities

Any HLAC course with C or higher.

Previous degree

Associate or bachelor degree posted on an official transcript.

Veteran status

Veteran status verified through the Veterans Services Office.

Upload before submitting

Upload every document or item you want considered before submitting. Additional documentation cannot be considered afterward.
