

TRADITIONAL NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION CHECKLIST

**This list is just an overview of the program requirements. Please visit http://www.slcc.edu/nursing/admissions/index.aspx for a more detailed description of the program requirements.

SLCC APPLICATION: Submit general Salt Lake Community College application at http://www.slcc.edu/apply/ . Declare your major as Pre-Medical & Health Sciences.
TRANSCRIPTS: Submit any transcripts from other schools you have attended ASAP. Instructions can be found at http://www.slcc.edu/student/transfer/transcripts.aspx .
*Official transcripts needs to be sent from EACH school you have attended. This includes transcripts for any AP credit you received during high school.
**It is highly recommended that students verify whether they have met all the program's prerequisite course requirements by checking their SLCC DegreeWorks. Instructions on how to do so can be found at http://www.slcc.edu/degreeworks/index.aspx .
TRANSFER EVALUATION REQUEST: Submit a transfer evaluation request for each of the transcripts you have submitted. Steps for how to do so can be found at http://www.slcc.edu/transcriptevaluation/ .
PREREQUISTE COURSES: Complete all prerequisite courses with minimum required grade or higher. Some prerequisite courses have timeframe and attempt requirements as well.
TEAS EXAM: Take TEAS exam and meet minimum score requirements.
CNA/MA EXPERIENCE: CNA or MA course completion or work experience is required. Verifiable documentation of the experience must be emailed to healthsciencesadmissions@slcc.edu by the program's application deadline.
PROGRAM APPLICATION: Submit Traditional Nursing Application by application deadline. Instructions can be found under "Apply to Nursing Program" at http://www.slcc.edu/nursing/admissions/index.aspx .
COMPLIO/IMMUNIZATIONS: It is no longer required that you purchase a Complio account/Background check for admission purposes. However, if you are accepted into the program, you will need to purchase a Complio account and Background Check as soon as possible AND fulfill all of the Immunization requirements before you start the program. **The Hepatitis B vaccination series can take up to 6 months to complete.
