

Spring 2024 Cohort Selective Admissions Requirements

PREREQUISITE COURSES

The following courses and labs (or equivalent transfer credit, AP or CLEP) must be completed by the Nursing Program's application deadlines, no exceptions. Each course and lab must be completed, with a C grade or better. Courses that have not been completed with a C grade or better will not be considered. Students taking courses **at SLCC, must complete all courses that will be considered on your application by August 31 if you plan to apply for spring and May 31 if you plan to apply for fall.** Transfer students must be complete by May 31 and have transcripts sent to the Transfer Evaluation Office by August 1 if you plan to apply for spring. Transfer students must be complete by December 31 and have transcripts sent to the Transfer Evaluation Office by March 15 if you plan to apply for fall.

Nursing students who have not completed the following support courses by the indicated timeframe with the required grades will not be eligible to advance in the Nursing program. **No Exceptions.**

- PSY 1100 or FHS 1500 (C or better, completed prior to beginning the third semester of the nursing program)
- Pathophysiology (C+ or better, completed **prior** to 2nd semester of Nursing program)
- ENGL 1010 (C or better, completed prior to beginning the third semester of the nursing program)

Additional consideration will be given to students who have these courses completed with the required grades at the time of program application.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT TRANSFER CREDIT

- Transcripts must be sent to the Transfer Evaluation Office by **March 15** for fall sessions, **August 1** for spring sessions. Grades must be posted to the transcripts at the time they are sent to the TEO.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure their transfer credit has been fully transferred to SLCC prior to the deadlines.
- Students should declare Health Sciences as their Area of Study and Nursing as the Program of Study when applying to SLCC. If the program of study does not match the information submitted on the transfer evaluation request, courses applicable to the program may not be transferred to SLCC.

VERIFICATION OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION OR EQUIVALENT (GED)

Verification of high school graduation or equivalent (GED) will be required before the (program) admissions deadline. Send official high school transcripts to HighSchoolTranscripts@slcc.edu.

PREFERRED BUT NOT REQUIRED

CNA LICENSING

Applicants with an active and unencumbered CNA license will receive additional consideration on the application.

OTHER LICENSING IN HEALTH CARE RELATED FIELDS

Applicants with an active and unencumbered license in a health care related field will receive additional consideration on the application.

DIRECT PATIENT CARE EXPERIENCE

Applicants that have direct patient care experience beyond 12 months will receive additional consideration on the application. Direct patient care for the purposes of admission would include any direct face-to-face, hands-on care administered to an individual in a healthcare setting. Applicants must submit a signed letter on letterhead by an employer stating job title, how long they held the position and the duties performed while employed. Experience does not need to be current.

Documentation that verifies licensing or patient care experience must be submitted to HealthSciencesAdmissions@slcc.edu within 5 days of submitting your application (application deadlines still apply).
