SUMMER 2026 COHORT SELECTIVE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

PREREQUISITE COURSES

All prerequisite courses (or equivalent transfer credit, AP or CLEP) must be completed by the Advanced Placement Nursing Program application deadline.

Each course and lab must be completed, with a C grade or better, except the Pathophysiology course which must be completed with a C+ or better. Courses that have not been completed with a C grade or better (or a C+ for Patho) will not be considered. Course deadlines can be found here.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT TRANSFER CREDIT

• It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure their transfer credit has been fully transferred to SLCC prior to the deadlines.

- Transcripts must be sent to the Transfer Evaluation Office by *March 15* for fall sessions, *August 1* for spring sessions and *October 30* for summer sessions. Grades must be posted to the transcripts at the time they are sent to the TEO.
- Students should declare their major as Pre-Health Sciences and specify which
 Health Sciences program they will be applying to when they submit their transfer
 evaluation request. If the correct information is not submitted within the transfer
 evaluation request, courses applicable to the program may not be transferred to
 SLCC.

VERIFICATION OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION OR EQUIVALENT (GED)

Proof of high school graduation is required to apply. Documentation may include a transcript, diploma or a letter of explanation if you do not have supporting documentation. **You will be required to upload this information as part of your application.**

UNENCUMBERED UTAH LPN LICENSE

Your LPN license must be current and in good standing in the State of Utah. You must submit a copy of your LPN license (that clearly shows your LPN license number) as part of your application.

PREFERRED BUT NOT REQUIRED

- **DIRECT PATIENT CARE EXPERIENCE** Applicants that have LPN work experience beyond 12 months will receive additional consideration on the application. Applicants must submit a signed letter on letterhead by an employer stating job title, how long they held the position and the duties performed while employed. Experience does not need to be current.
- Graduated from an AHEC program

Extra consideration will be given for students with the following:

- ENGL 2010 or ENGL 2100 or HONS 2211(Must be C grade or better)
- ECON 1740 or HIST 1700 or POLS 1100 (Must be C grade or better)
- Any HLAC Course (Must be C grade or better)
- Prior associates and/or bachelor's degree. Degree(s) must be posted on official college transcript.
- Verified Veteran's status through the Veteran's Service Office.

Any document or information you wish to have considered on your application must be uploaded while completing your application. Additional documentation cannot be considered once you have submitted your application.
