

## SLCC Electrician License Renewal—Licensure Information

SLCC's [Electrician License Renewal Continuing Education](#) (CE) courses at SLCC are approved by the [Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing \(DOPL\)](#) to meet the CE requirements for electrician license renewal.

Completion of the Electrician License Renewal CE courses does not guarantee the ability to obtain or renew a Utah state electrician's license to practice as an electrician. Licensure is the exclusive right and responsibility of each state. In order to practice as an electrician, students must satisfy individual state requirements, independent of SLCC requirements. It is highly recommended that students consult in advance with [DOPL](#), or similar agencies in other states, to find out more about eligibility for licensure.
