As a part of the [SLCC Radiologic Technology](#) program students prepare to take the national [American Registry of Radiologic Technologist \(ARRT\)](#) certification examination. The SLCC Radiologic Technology program is accredited by Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities and additionally by the [Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology \(JRCERT\)](#), and has been awarded the full 8 year award.

Attending an accredited Radiologic Technology program and passing the ARRT national certification exam are the steps for preparing for professional licensure in radiologic technology. In order to work as a Radiologic Technologist, students must satisfy individual state requirements, independent of SLCC graduation requirements. It is highly recommended that students consult in advance with the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL), or other state licensure agencies, to find out more about eligibility for licensure.
