Please read through all the step-by-step instructions before beginning the state risk Defensive Driving Training course.

You must complete Driver Training to:

- be authorized to drive on college business
- receive college motor pool privileges
- be authorized for mileage reimbursement
- participate in the separate High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) training

2. Utah Learning Portal: New Registration

To create a new profile:

1. Enter your first and last name as they appear on your driver license
2. Enter your @slcc.edu email
3. Enter “slcc” as the Security Keyword
4. Click Sign up to complete your registration

3. Utah Learning Portal: Getting Started

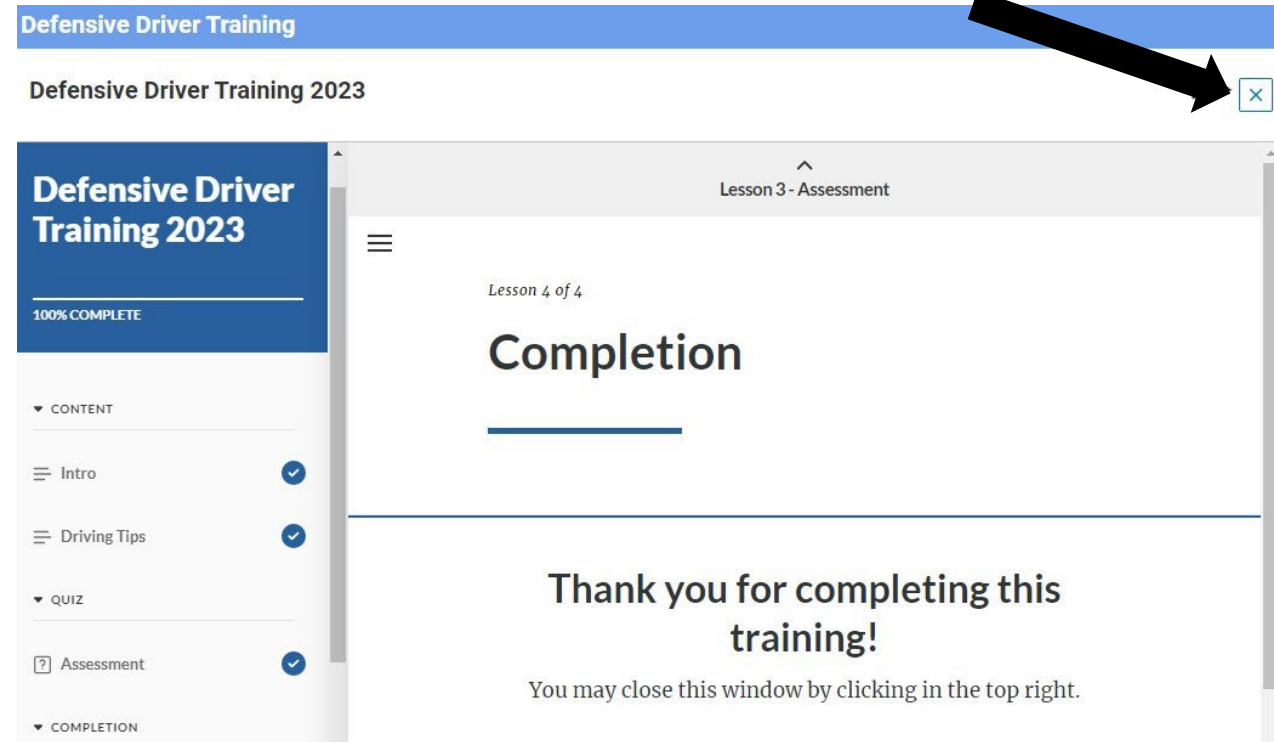
Once signed into the Utah Learning Portal, select Defensive Driver Training to begin the “Defensive Driver Training” course.

1. Make certain to open the current session, not a previously completed session.
2. The course may not be able to launch if pop-ups are blocked in your web browser. (See [UPenn’s resource on enabling browser pop-ups.](#))



4. Utah Learning Portal: Defensive Driver Training

1. Watch the videos and complete the activities.
2. Take the 25-question multiple choice test.
3. When you have passed the test, proceed to Lesson 4: Completion.
4. Click the "X" in the top right corner to exit.



5. Utah Learning Portal: Print Your Certificate

1. Click on the Print Certificate option under the Defensive Driver Training home page.

6. Submit Your Documents Online

To complete driver training:

1. Fill out the [Mileage / Motor Pool Authorization Etrieve Form](#)
2. Use the “Attachments” button at the bottom of the form to upload:
 - your certificate
 - a picture of your driver’s license
3. Click “Submit” at the bottom of the form.

Note: CDL drivers may be required to upload copies of additional documentation (e.g., medical card)

7. High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Training

Note: Driver Training and HOV Training are two separate trainings.

If you wish to drive an HOV vehicle, you will need to complete BOTH trainings.

1. Complete the Defensive Driver Training
2. Fill out and submit all required documentation via the [Mileage / Motor Pool Authorization Etrieve Form](#).
3. Contact the [Motor Pool Office](#) to schedule your hands-on HOV driving test.
