Non-Credit/Competency Based to Credit Course Equivalency

The purpose of the Non-Credit/Competency Based to Credit Equivalency procedure is to create a successful bridge for students who move from a non-credit/competency based program to an AS, AA or AAS degree program.

Once the student successfully completes the School of Applied Technology or Workforce and Economic Development/Continuing Education non-credit and/or competency based program, (individual courses will not be considered) the qualifying student meets with an Academic Advisor and completes the SLCC Non-Credit/Competency Based Credit Equivalent Application. The applicable undergraduate (UG) credit program which aligns with the approved Equivalency Agreement is selected.
