As an MA Student, you will receive training in both the administrative and clinical areas of medical assisting to keep offices and clinics running smoothly under the direction of a physician. As a certified MA you will:

- take and record vital signs
- generate medical histories
- prep patients for examination
- draw blood
- administer prescribed medications
