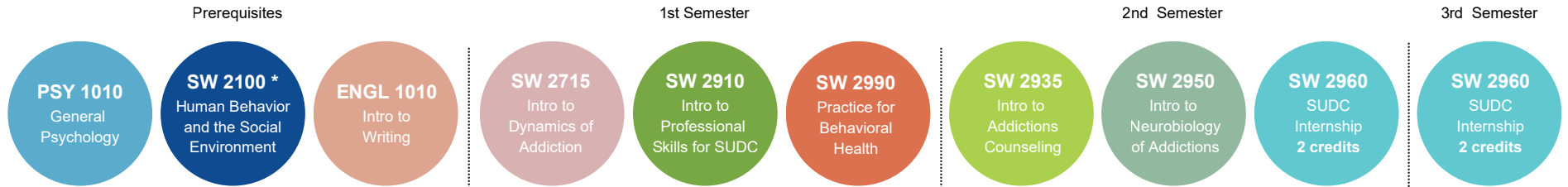

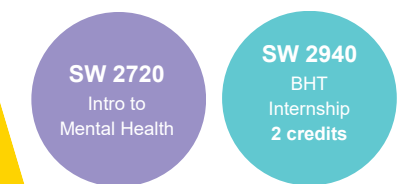


Courses to take towards SSW



- Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree
 - – OR –
- Master's degree in Psychology, Marriage and Family Therapy or Mental Health Counseling
 - – OR –
- Bachelor's degree in another field AND
 - Completion of three semester hours (or the equivalent) each in the areas of Social Welfare Policy, Human Growth and Development (across the lifespan), and Social Work Practice Methods
 - Completion of 2,000 hours of qualifying experience
 - Supervisor approval of 2,000 hours

Courses to take towards BHCM



- Upon successful completion of the SLCC BHCM certificate training (listed below), students will work with the Utah Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to apply for the Behavioral Health Case Management.
- Successful completion of SW2720-Case Management and Mental Health (with a 'C' grade or higher)
- Completion of the SW2940 required 60-hour community internship
- Passing the formal DHHS BHCM examination with a score of 70% or higher (completed in SW2720)

*Exceptions of FHS 1500 or PSY 1100 for SW 2100 might be possible upon approval. Consult with program personnel
