- DISCOVER SLCC Peer mentoring program
  - Name change from former “Pathways” to “Discover”
  - “Underrepresented Students” work group formed with community and college partners
- LGBTQ+ Initiative
  - Monthly SafeZone training implemented
  - Website subcommittee formed; updates in process
  - LGBTQ+ Resource Center/Lending Library created with significant gifts from the estate of Jonathan Stowers
  - LGBTQ+ Center subcommittee formed; visiting other College centers to gain ideas to present a proposal for FY16-17
- Horizonte Instruction and Training Center partnership
  - Scholarship board has agreed to create expectation that scholarship recipients will participate in DISCOVER SLCC
- Refugee Education Initiative
  - 120 participants will participate in a June 29, 2015 Orientation at South City Campus
  - Incoming supported students will be directed to enroll at SLCC
  - Participants will be supported by DISCOVER SLCC

**Assessment Highlights:** (Please use bullet format.)

- DISCOVER SLCC
  - 54 students applied for the program and registered for classes during the course of the year with an average participation of 27 enrolled students at any given time. The goal was 60.
  - 74% rate of persistence from fall 2014 to spring 2015
  - 88% rate of persistence from spring 2015 to summer or fall 2015
- LGBTQ+ SafeZone training
  - Nearly 90 staff, faculty and students have been trained in SafeZone since February 2015
