

Five Steps to

Keeping Your Garden Tidy



As a community gardener it is your responsibility to care for your garden plot and the surrounding spaces to maintain a healthy garden area for everyone to enjoy!



Water new plantings regularly

Keep newly planted seeds and young plants extra moist until their roots have grown and established in the soil.



Remove the weeds

Remove weeds that grow in and around your plot. They steal nutrients from desired plants, harbor pests & spread rapidly to other plots!



Inspect for pests

Watch for insect pests, eggs & bite marks on your plants. Pests are a natural part of gardening but if the populations get too high it can become a serious problem.



Harvest regularly

Allowing vegetables to overripen and decay in your plot will attract pests & it's a waste! Let us know if you need us to donate any of your produce to the Bruin Pantry!



Dispose of trash & debris

Do not leave trash or plant debris lying around the garden. Please put them in the bins or dumpsters.
