Statement of Understanding

Standards of Progress for Veterans

Attending Salt Lake Community College under VA GI Education Funds

This statement of understanding will demonstrate that the veteran/dependent enrolled at Salt Lake Community College (SLCC) using ANY VA GI Educational Funds is aware of the academic standards of progress for SLCC, the US Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA), and the State Approving Agency (SAA). If you have questions regarding this document, contact a SLCC Certifying Official for clarification.

This applies to those in receipt of VA Educational funds and not to enrollment at SLCC.

Standards of Progress Guidelines

SLCC students to remain in good academic standing are to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0. *The same standards apply to veterans/dependents attending SLCC while receiving VA Educational funds.*

NOTE: *A cumulative GPA of 2.0 must be achieved in order to graduate from SLCC and be considered making Successful Academic Progress.*

1. When a student's **semester** GPA falls below a 2.0 for two consecutive terms, the student:
 - will be sent a letter placing him/her on academic probation for one semester,
 - must meet with the VetSuccess on Campus Counselor to develop a plan to improve academic performance and **provide a copy of the plan to the SLCC Veterans Services Certifying Official**
 - must sign a "Plan for Academic Success" with the SLCC Veterans Services Certifying Official,
 - must complete the following semester with a minimum of 2.0 GPA and follow all terms in academic performance plan listed on the letter of probation.

2. When a student's **cumulative** GPA falls below a 2.0, not including the first term, the student:
 - will be sent a letter placing him/her on academic probation for one semester,
 - must meet with the VetSuccess on Campus Counselor to develop a plan to improve academic performance and **provide a copy of the plan to the SLCC Veterans Services Certifying Official**,
 - must sign a "Plan for Academic Success" with the SLCC Veterans Services Certifying Official,
 - must complete next semester with a minimum of 2.0 cumulative GPA and follow terms in performance plan.

I understand Failure to follow and meet these requirements will result in VA Academic Suspension. I will not receive VA education benefits until standards are met and may result in an overpayment notice from the US Department of Veterans Affairs.

I understand the standards of progress requirements at SLCC and the US Dept. of Veterans Affairs in regards to the use of the VA GI Educational Funds as indicated above and the penalties if my GPA falls below a 2.0.
