Medical Interpreter

BASICS

Medical interpreters serve a critical role in the community by interpreting communication between the staff and non-English speaking population, and helping to ensure a quality medical experience for patients and loved ones.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- This course will be taught for learners with **Arabic**/English bilingual proficiency.
- Successful completion of this course allows students to apply for Tier 2 Medical Interpreter certification with the Utah Department of Commerce's Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL). See website for more information.

PREREQUISITES:

1. English Proficiency Exam from Salt Lake Community College.
2. Official High School Diploma or higher (or equivalent) from country of origin.

COST:

- Apply the Medical Interpreter Code of Ethics, HIPAA privacy rules, Utah Mandatory Reporting rules and professional standards for medical interpreters.
- Demonstrate effective interaction skills with medical professionals and clients.
- Demonstrate cultural competency in medical interpreting communications.
- Complete all medical interpreter sessions, following industry guidelines.
